Hazard likely to occur once in more than 2 years - Very Rarely	No Action is required and no documentary record needs to be kept	Physical control required. Consideration may be given to a more cost effective solution or improvement that imposes no additional cost burden. Monitoring is required to ensure that the controls are maintained. Planned training of respective persons needs to be conducted on regular basis.	Efforts should be made to reduce the risk with proper planning of budget as cost of preventive measures. Risk reduction measure should be implemented. Planned training of respective persons at risk needs to be conducted on regular basis.	Periodic review need to be performed and suitable action to be taken in order to reduce such risk. All persons involved in such risk should be well aware about the same. Financial budget need to be allocated to reduce the risk and evidence of risk reduction to be maintained. Cover status in MRM

Hazard likely to occur once in less than 6 months - Unpredictably	Efforts should be made to reduce the risk with proper planning of budget as cost of preventive measures. Risk reduction measure should be implemented. Planned training of respective persons at risk needs to be conducted on regular basis.	Periodic review need to be performed and suitable action to be taken in order to reduce such risk. All persons involved in such risk should be well aware about the same. Financial budget need to be allocated to reduce the risk and evidence of risk reduction to be maintained. Cover status in MRM	Work should not be started until the risk has been reduced to moderate or substantial level. The resources have to be allocated to reduce the risk. Where the risk involves work in progress (unpredictably), immediate action should be taken and evidence recorded. Further, management approval is mandate to proceed with same work.
